Attention Exhibitors

FOOD: Safely served coffee and individually wrapped snacks will be available. Feel free to bring refreshments.

CANINE COURTESY: All dogs are to be kept under control at all times. All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged. Retractable leashes may NOT be used on show grounds. Designated exercise areas will be available. Exhibitors who fail to clean up after their dogs anywhere on show grounds, including outside the facility, will be subject to an Event Committee hearing and a fine.

PUPPIES: Per the Rules Applying to Dog Shows, only dogs that are eligible to be shown shall be allowed within the show precincts. Please leave dogs under 6 months old at home.

ARRIVAL: Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging.

JUDGING: Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. It is the responsibility of the owner/handler to have the dog at ringside when required and without being called.

PRACTICING: No practicing allowed in rings at any time. A practice ring will be available.

CRATING: Please provide your own chairs and crates. Pads **must** be provided under wire or plastic crates.

HEALTH: Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

SMOKING: No smoking allowed in the building.

CHILDREN: Parents must be responsible for their children at all times.

UNLOADING: Unloading will be allowed only in designated areas and vehicles must be removed within a reasonable time.

At this time, no easing of state, county, or host facility requirements have been announced. All applicable covid19 precautions will be enforced at the trial. Properly fitted masks (covering nose and mouth) must be worn, including while in the ring. When an exhibitor is done for the day, they should leave the grounds in order to minimize congregating.

ROUTES TO THE SHOW

The College Settlement Outdoor School Kuhn's Day Camp is located in 597/600 Witmer Rd Horsham, PA, about 15 miles north of Philadelphia.

From the Pennsylvania Turnpike:

Take exit #343 and bear left for route 611 South. At first traffic light make a right onto Maryland Road. Go about 3/10 of a mile to top of hill and bear right at first traffic light onto Commerce Avenue. Follow Commerce Avenue through three traffic lights (it will change its name to Witmer Road at Blair Mill Road).

The entrance to Day Camp is about one mile beyond the 2nd traffic light on the right.

From Route 309 North:

Take the exit for Norristown Road. At end of ramp make a right onto Norristown Road. Follow about three miles, to sixth traffic light. Make a right onto Witmer Road. The entrance to Day Camp is located a little over a mile down on the left-hand side.

From Broad Street/Route 611:

Follow Broad Street North to Route 611 North. Stay on 611 North through Jenkintown and Abington. A few miles north of Abington Hospital, take a left onto Route 63-West. Follow this for 4 miles and make a right onto Dresher Road (Cardinal Auto Lube is on the corner). Follow Dresher Road to the 2nd traffic light and make a left onto Witmer Road. The entrance to College Settlement is a little more than a mile down on the left.

From Philadelphia/I-95 North:

Take I-95 North to exit for Woodhaven Road-Route 63. Follow 63 West to exit for Route 1 North. Follow Route 1 North to PA Turnpike (276)- Take exit for Turnpike West/Harrisburg. Travel on turnpike about 6 miles to first exit#343-Willow Grove. Follow direction above.

From Western Suburbs:

Take I-476 North (Blue Route) to the PA Turnpike/I-276 East. Follow directions from Exit 343 as above.

From NJ:

From Hunterdon County area, take US-202 South to PA-611 South and follow directions above. From Mercer or Burlington Counties, take the PA Turnpike West and follow directions above.
