
News from our Members



Excerpt from the AKC's website

There are over 500 member clubs that meet AKC's membership requirements, hold AKC member events at which AKC titles may be earned, and have duly elected or appointed Delegates who represent the club at quarterly meetings of the delegate body; licensed clubs meet certain requirements to be able offer events which are in all respects identical to AKC member events, but licensed clubs do not have delegate representation; sanctioned clubs are those in the process of fulfilling requirements to become licensed clubs and sponsor match events, where dogs gain experience but not titles.
