ROUTES TO THE SHOW

FROM US 422:

Take Route 202 South for approximately 10 miles.

Take the US-30-Business Route/US-30 East exit toward EXTON/FRAZER. At the bottom of the exit ramp, turn RIGHT onto LINCOLN HWY/US-30 BUSINESS West. Go approximately 1 mile on East LINCOLN HWY/US 30 BUSINESS WEST. Turn LEFT onto SPRINGDALE DRIVE. The East Lincoln Highway entrance to Springdale Drive is posted as Whiteland Business Park. Dog Training Center of Chester County (DTCCC) is the 1st building on the left. The entrance faces Springdale Drive. Look for the black awning above the door. Parking is available around the building and in the lot across from the front entrance.

FROM PA Turnpike from the East:

Exit PA Turnpike at the Valley Forge Exit. Follow signs for 202 South. Follow as above.

FROM PA Turnpike from the West:

Exit PA Turnpike at the Downingtown Exit (#312). Take Route 100 South for 4.5 miles. Turn Left onto Route 30 BUSINESS. Go 1.5 miles and turn right on Springdale Drive. Follow as above.

FROM I-95 from the South:

Exit US-202N/Concord Pike (Exit 8). Go about 20 miles. Exit onto Route 30 Business. Go approximately 1 mile and turn left on Springdale Drive. Follow as above.

Unloading at the building is permitted – flashers should be left on, 10 minutes max

TRIAL INFORMATION AND REGULATIONS

Trial competition will use one ring.

Entries can be made online or by mail. **Enter online** with no surcharge at <https://showentries.info/>. Entry fees must be paid with online entry submission. **Mail-in entry** forms are available at [ShowEntriesInfo.com](https://showentries.info/) for download. If a check is returned, PDTC will add any bank fees to the amount due. Entries are acknowledged via email as soon as they are received and processed. Please be sure to add [ShowEntriesInfo.com](https://showentries.info/) to your email allowed list.

PLEASE VERIFY THE ACCURACY OF YOUR ENTRY INFORMATION as soon as you receive the processing email and respond immediately if any changes are noted. Changes or corrections to entry forms must be received via email prior to the close of entries.

Armband numbers are confirmed and judging programs are distributed via email for all entries shortly after closing, when final judging assignments are complete.

Refunds are allowed if requested before the closing date. Refunds are allowed after closing for Bitches in season only. There is a \$5.00 processing fee per entry for ALL refunds (each entry, not each dog). For AKC events, Bitches in season are not eligible to participate in Rally trials. A refund will be issued for the bitch in season entry. Notification in writing, that includes a veterinarian's verification, on official business letterhead, must be given to the trial secretary no later than 30 minutes prior to the start of the first class, of the day of the trial.

No refunds for errors on entry forms, or if a dog is absent, disqualified, or excused by a veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.

No refunds if the show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the club. If cancellation is decided before the event, notification will be posted on: philadelphiadogtraining.org

Transfers will be accepted per AKC regulations if you have earned a new title after closing, and if the class is not full. Completed and signed transfer form must be submitted to the Trial Secretary no later than 30 minutes prior to the start of judging for the trial. Click [AKC Rally Trial Transfer Form](#) to download a copy of the form. Due to Judging Limits, we cannot guarantee that all requested Transfers can be accommodated.

Jump Heights will be in ASCENDING (small to tall) order for all classes

SIGN-IN and CRATING

There will be a secretary table for check-ins and information inside the building.

Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging.

Dogs must be exercised/curbed in the designated potty area and not on landscaping in the grounds, as noted by signs prohibiting dogs in foundation landscaping. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of a refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available on the grounds.

Indoor crating space available in designated areas.

No ex-pens in the building.

LEASHES AND HARNESES

All dogs must be kept on a leash except when in the rally ring and must be brought into and taken out of the ring on leash.

Dogs must wear a collar. Dogs may wear slip collars or buckle collars. Nothing may be hanging from the dog's collar. They may not wear prong collars, e-collars, head collars, muzzles, or body harnesses. Leashes need only be long enough to provide adequate slack and should be made of fabric, leather, or biothane.

No Flexi leashes permitted in the building.

FACILITIES

NO OVERNIGHT RV PARKING before, during, or after the event is permitted anywhere on the grounds.

Generators and propane tanks are not permitted in the building nor on the grounds.

No tents or private exercise pens are permitted to be set up anywhere on the grounds.

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all exercises safely. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such a case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The **American Kennel Club** and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The **American Kennel Club** reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against **the American Kennel Club** or any official thereof.

PHILADELPHIA DOG TRAINING CLUB, INC.(PDTC) assumes no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property or vehicle and further assumes no responsibility for children. Exhibitors shall hold the Event Committee harmless and indemnify it against any legal proceeding arising from any accident.

There will be **no intensive or abusive training** of the dogs on the grounds. **Physical or verbal disciplining of a dog will not be permitted.** The Event Chair, Event Secretary, and Event Committee members shall be responsible for compliance with this section and shall investigate any reports of infractions.

HEALTH: Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to ensure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

DECLINATION OF ENTRIES/REMOVAL OF DOG: The Event Committee may refuse to admit or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness, or other cause, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the show-giving club or any official thereof.

If applicable, PA, local, and host facility covid19 precautions will be enforced. Subject to change.

Please provide your own chairs and crates. Coffee and snacks will be available all day. Feel free to bring refreshments. No smoking is allowed in the facility.
